

Resolution No.: 2021-8169

**Regulation pertaining to the Crowley County Planning and Zoning Manual,
Section 14, regarding the Use by Review of Marijuana Properties**

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. § 30-11-103, the Board of County Commissioners of Crowley County, Colorado (hereinafter the "Board"), has the authority to exercise all County powers for the Unincorporated Areas of Crowley County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Crowley County, Colorado has the authority pursuant to C.R.S. §30-11-101(2), to adopt and enforce ordinances and resolutions regarding health, safety and welfare issues; and


WHEREAS, the growth of the marijuana industry in Crowley County has expanded greatly; and

WHEREAS, the finite resources of Crowley County need to be measured and utilized to the greatest effect.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, Resolution No. 2021-8044, with an effective date of April 1, 2021, which placed a six-month moratorium on use by review applications for marijuana cultivation properties, is being amended to reflect that the moratorium will remain in effect until the Board of County Commissioners wishes to change the status of the moratorium.
