## RESOLUTION NO. 2021-8076

APPROVE RESOLUTION FOR SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET AND APPROPRIATION

Motion by McMillian, seconded by Elliott to approve the following supplemental budget and appropriation:

A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL SUMS OF MONEY TO DEFRAY EXPENSES IN EXCESS OF AMOUNTS BUDGETED FOR THE COUNTY OF CROWLEY, COLORADO.

WHEREAS, the receipt of funds from the Small Business Relief Grant 2021, in the amount of \$115,198, was not assured at the time of the adoption of the 2021 budget, and;

WHEREAS, the receipt of funds related to the closeout of FEMA PW219 Grant 2014, in the amount of 57,399.57, was still in negotiation at the time of the adoption of the 2021 budget, and;

WHEREAS, during the Colorado Department of Transportation 2019 State Highway 71 bridge replacement project, significant damage occurred to Crowley County Lane 20. The Colorado Department of Transportation has agreed to pay the County for damage to the county lane. Receipt of funds in the amount of \$50,000, is expected to be received in 2021, and;

WHEREAS, the receipt of funds from the Firefighter Safety & Disease Prevention Grant 2020, in the amount of \$12,270, were expected to be received in December 2020, so was not included in the 2021 budget. Funds were not received until 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CROWLEY COUNTY, COLORDO;

Section 1. That the 2021 appropriation for the General Fund, Auxiliary Services, line number 10.543.59528 SBA Grant Expenditure is hereby increased from \$0.00 to \$115,198 for the following purpose: funds will be distributed to eligible small businesses in Crowley County, who were impacted by severe capacity restrictions due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Section 2. That the 2021 appropriation for the Road and Bridge Fund, Maintenance of Condition, line number 20.620.52000 Capital Outlay is hereby increased from \$250,000 to \$307,400 for the following purpose: funds from the closeout of the FEMA PW2019 Grant 2014 will be utilized to purchase necessary equipment for the Road and Bridge district departments.

Section 3. That the 2021 appropriation for the Road and Bridge Fund, Maintenance of Condition, line number 20.620.51226 Road Oil is hereby increased from \$211,700 to \$251,700, and line number 20.620.51227 Chips is hereby increased from \$51,350 to \$61,350 for the following purpose: repairs to road damage caused by the CDOT Hwy 71 bridge replacement project.

Section 4. That the 2021 appropriation for the EMS/Fire Fund, EMS Administration, line number 30.634.51167 Casualty/Property Insurance is hereby increased from \$7,550 to \$10,905, and line number 30.634.51380 is hereby increased from \$500 to \$2,000 for the following purpose: to defray the additional expense of casualty and property insurance coverage related to Fire/EMS departments, as well as repair and maintenance costs to the EMS/Fire/Ambulance building.

Section 5. That the 2021 appropriation for the EMS/Fire Fund, Fire Expenditures, line number 30.631.52001 Ordway Subsidy is hereby increased from \$10,500 to \$12,353, and line number 30.631.52003 Olney Springs Subsidy is hereby increased from \$3,500 to \$5,353, and line number 30.631.52004 Sugar City Subsidy is hereby increased from \$3,500 to \$5,353, and line number 30.631.52005 Crowley Subsidy is hereby increased from \$3,500 to \$5,356 for the following purpose: to provide additional operational funds to each of the town fire departments.
