Motion by Elliott, seconded by McMillian to decline county participation in the State's Family Medical and Leave Insurance (FAMLI) program. The resolution follows:

FORMAL DECLINATION OF PARTICIPATION IN FAMLI

WHEREAS, the County of Crowley is a local government employer; and

WHEREAS, the County of Crowley provides insurance coverage for its employees; and

WHEREAS, employees of Crowley County may personally choose to elect coverage through FAMLI; and

WHEREAS, the additional cost of FAMLI would not be economically feasible.

BE IT RESOLVED by the County of Crowley as follows:

1. The County of Crowley DECLINES to participate in FAMLI.
2. The County of Crowley shall forward this resolution to the Division.
3. The County of Crowley will provide written/electronic notice to each employee informing the employee of the employee's right to opt into FAMLI.
4. The County of Crowley will provide access to each employee for the employee to compare and contrast FAMLI with the current Family Medical Leave Act (FMLA) benefit.
