MONTHLY PRISON MEETING

The board conducted the monthly prison meeting with a representative of Crowley County Correctional Facility. No representatives attended from Arkansas Valley Correctional Facility. Those in attendance were:

CCCF: There are currently 9 correctional officer vacancies; they are in a very good position as they are at 94-95% of full staff levels. They are currently at 1,347 beds, but they are able and ready to increase inmate capacity should the State need the additional beds. Currently, the budget is set to fund 2,700 beds for both Bent and Crowley Counties. They are getting a lot of first-time offenders (first time in prison). The outcome of the vulnerability Assessment as very good. Current goals are reducing front-line turnover by 25%, and meeting profitability marks. They will be having Reunification for Black History Month. All other programs are up and running well. Joan appreciated the opportunity to sit in on the meeting. Legislators are hearing misinformation of what is happening at private prisons.

No further business appearing the meeting was recessed.
