# OTHER BUSINESS OR DISCUSSION

The Cheyenne Mountain Roofing proposal has been tabled. The commissioners want to try to obtain a few more bids.

Gary Massey and Eric Roberts, Trustees for the Town of Sugar City, stopped by to talk to the commissioners concerning a major water leak located on the corner of Nebraska and Highway 96. There are three valves underneath Highway 96, and in order to access them they will need to obtain approval from Colorado Department of Transportation to close down the road. The Town of Sugar City does not have the manpower or funding to repair this leak. Gary and Eric asked if the County would be willing to pay for the repairs. All three commissioners agreed they would likely be willing to cover the cost, but they do want to see quotes.

McMillian brought up that the Sugar City Volunteer Fire Department need a pump and a water tank. They found the items available for \$3,000. They have enough funds to pay for half of the cost and wanted to know if Crowley County

would be willing to pay for the remaining \$1,500. All three commissioners agreed to issue a check to the Sugar City Volunteer Fire Department for \$1,500.

Ellicott Fire Department came down and looked an the old ambulance that we want to dispose of. They found a few things wrong with it. They are going to talk it over to determine if they wish to make an offer to purchase it.
