

**NOTICE**  
**Mail Ballot Election**

Crowley County will have a Mail Ballot Election on November 2, 2021 for all registered voters. To vote you must be a resident of Colorado by October 13, 2021.

If you are registered and have made any changes to your residence or mailing address, please contact our office. Residents who are eligible should expect to receive their ballot by mail the week of October 18, 2021. If you believe you should receive a ballot and have not received it by October 25, you must call this office at 267-5225 to verify your registration and mailing address. Ballots cannot be mailed after October 25. If you make a change to your voter record after October 25, you must pick up your ballot in person. If you spoil, deface or lose your ballot you may obtain a replacement ballot, one at a time, not to exceed three ballots in all. To vote or replace a ballot contact the Crowley County Clerk Monday–Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.; on Saturday October 30, 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.; on Election Day from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. All current registered voters will receive a ballot by mail but you do not have to return it by mail. You may hand deliver your ballot to the Crowley County Clerk and Recorder's Office, 631 Main, Suite 102, Ordway, CO by 7:00 p.m. on election day on November 2, 2021.

Your ballot may be returned by mail by affixing fifty-eight cents postage but must be received by 7:00 p.m on Election Day to be counted. If you choose to mail your ballot, please mail in time to be received by November 2, 2021. Post marks **DO NOT COUNT** as received. A walk-up 24 hour ballot drop box is available at the front of the building.
