Welcome to the 2024 Tax Sale for Tax Year 2023 Bidding Rules for Crowley County Tax Lien Sale

Interest Rate for Tax Lien Sale will be 15%

Procedures:

Sales will be listed on www.govease.com/auctions under Colorado-Crowley County. The opening bid will be listed. Then the bidding will proceed in premium bids. The minimum bid increments will be \$1.00 for all items. (Note: Premium bids are at the investor's expense, do not accrue interest and are not refundable when the tax lien is redeemed.)

If no bid is received at the end of the tax lien sale, the schedule will be offered at a later date within 10 days of the end of sale. If no bids are received after the 2nd offering, the tax lien will be struck off to the County. Such liens are available for purchase starting the day after the 2nd sale and continuing for one week after.

THE TAX LIEN SALE IS A BUYER BEWARE SALE. ALL SALES ARE FINAL. It is the purchaser's responsibility to determine the status of any property offered at tax lien sale. Purchase of a tax lien is done at the purchaser's own risk.

Purchase of a tax lien should be considered, first and foremost, as a loan to the property owner at the specified annual rate of interest with the property as collateral for the loan. All redemptions must be made through the Treasurer's Office. It is not within the investor's rights to contact the property owner regarding the tax lien or to encourage the property owner to pay the tax lien investor directly.

The treasurer has attempted to exclude items from sale where they are protected under the Bankruptcy Code. If a lien is wrongfully sold and the County must redeem as "Sold in Error", the redemption interest will be calculated as set forth in CRS 39-12-111.

We cannot guarantee a property to be buildable or desirable. We may not know if the land has a Conservation Easement involved or the ramifications if there is one. Occasionally we have taxes that are "improvements only on leased land" and that situation could be risky also.

The Towns of Crowley County will certify special assessments (weed & water) that will be added to the 2024 Taxes on some schedules — that information will be received in our office by December 15th.

Tax liens expire after 15 years from the date of sale. It is the investor's responsibility to exercise their right to a deed if so desired. You will not receive notice from the Treasurer's office that your tax lien is about to expire.

The tax lien certificate to be issued on successful bid will be in the statutory form, showing lawful rates of Interest for four years. The holder of a tax lien certificate will pay the year of purchase, and three following years, before application and issuance of a Treasurer's Deed. Certificates will not be issued in the name other than the name or names on the registration. There is a \$4.00 charge for the certificate of purchase. All certificates <u>must</u> be endorsed (paid) each August until redeemed or deeded. There is a \$5.00 endorsement fee per certificate. <u>We prefer safe keeping the certificate in our office (copies are available upon request)</u>. If certificate is kept by owner and lost, there is a \$25.00 replacement fee.
